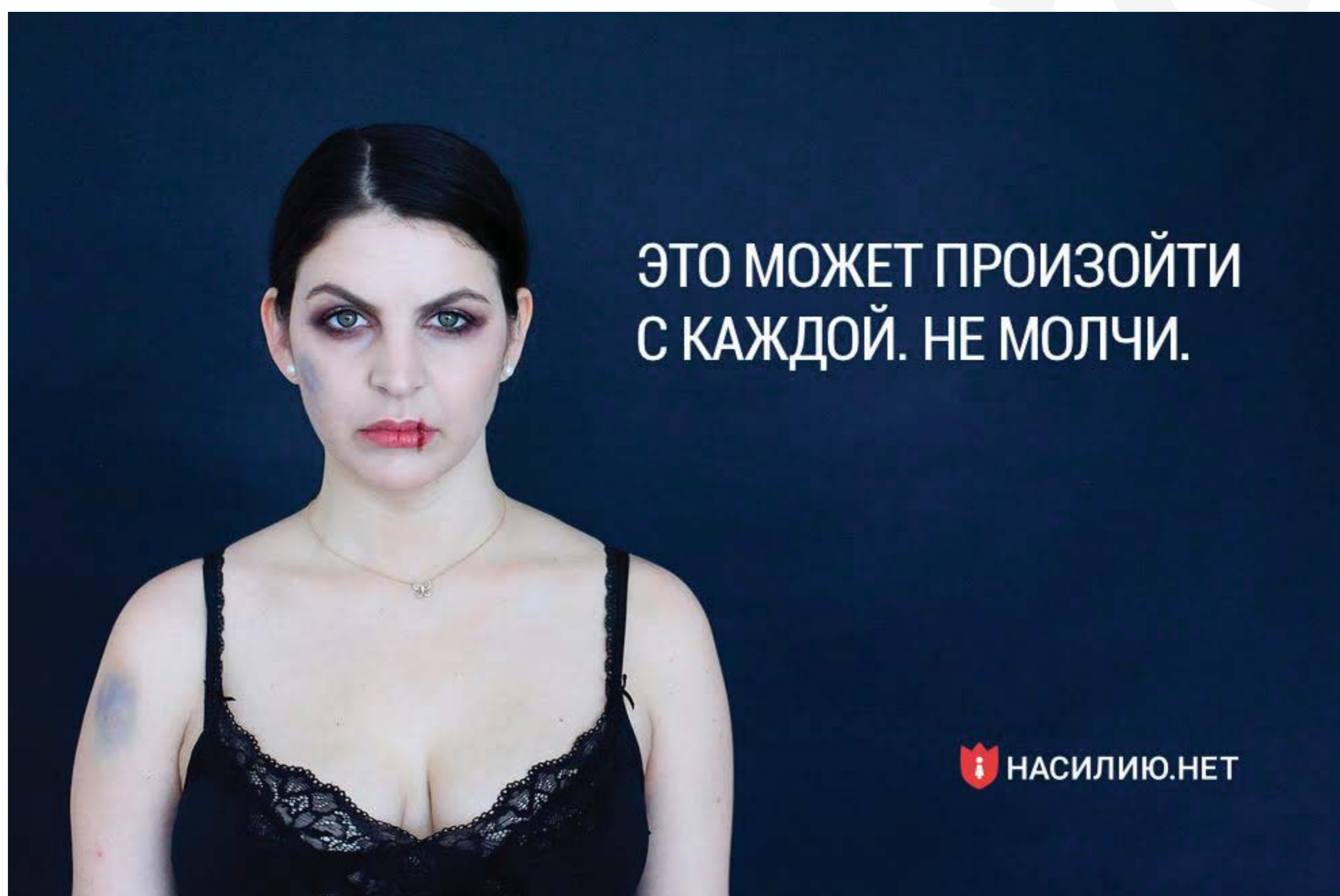
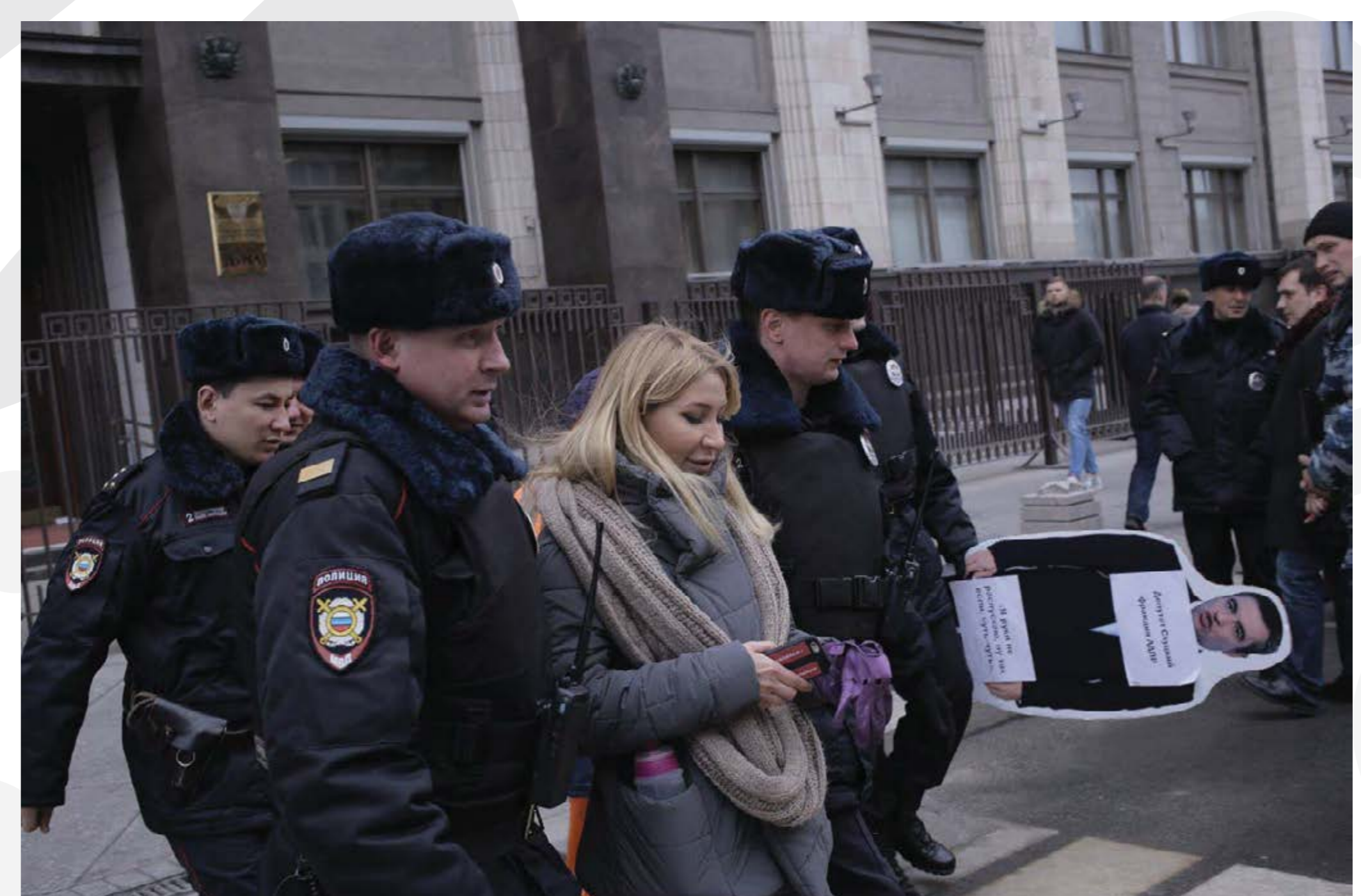


## Russia
